



## Overview

This course assists primary care staff to support patients living with the late effects commonly experienced after colorectal cancer treatment. You will be presented with interactive video consultations based on Simon, a patient recovering from surgery, radiotherapy and chemotherapy. The videos are accompanied by a range of activities to reinforce key learning points.

- Enable patients to articulate their concerns around fear of recurrence and provide appropriate reassurance
- Understand how to support a patient presenting with peripheral neuropathy, altered bowel habit and sexual dysfunction
